



PLUMBING AND DRAINAGE

Prior to undertaking any plumbing and drainage work on a new connection you will need to obtain a Plumbing Permit from the Weipa Town Authority (WTA)

How to submit an application?

Please follow steps below:

1. Complete Form 1 Compliance assessment application for plumbing, drainage and on site sewerage work. Forms are available from WTA office or online at www.hpw.qld.gov.au
2. Attach a site, floor and drainage plan showing the location of fixtures, inspection openings and connection to local jump-up. (refer example site)
3. Submit to agray@astutecertification.com.au

Notifiable plumbing work

When undertaking plumbing work on an existing connection, your licensed plumber may undertake this without a plumbing permit.

In this case your licensed plumber must report this work to the QBCC within 10 business days by submitting a Notifiable Work Form 4 refer www.qbcc.qld.gov.au

Plumbing Inspections

A minimum of three inspections are required for compliance assessable work, comprising underslab and/or underslung, sewer connection and final stage.

WTA requires a minimum 48 hrs notice for plumbing inspections. Please call 07 3183 2500 or email agray@astutecertification.com.au to make a booking.

New water connections

Details of your new water connections must be provided when completing the Form 1 Compliance assessment application for plumbing, drainage and on site sewerage work.
