Weipa Town Authority is seeking multiple lifeguards to join the Weipa Aquatic and Sports Precinct team for the upcoming summer season. These roles suit applicants who enjoy active, outdoor work and are committed to maintaining a safe and welcoming environment for pool patrons.

Training

Applicants who do not already hold a valid lifeguard qualification must attend the scheduled training below. First Aid and CPR are included. Alternative training may be arranged by the applicant outside Weipa if required. Successful applicants aged 14–15 years are only eligible to participate in the Bronze Medallion course.

- **Lifeguard course:** Monday 7 September and Tuesday 8 September, 9:00 am–4:00 pm each day.
- **Bronze Medallion course:** Monday 7 September, 9:00 am–4:00 pm and Tuesday 8 September, 1:30 pm–4:00 pm

Ongoing training: All staff receive practical, on-shift training and support from the Aquatic Team Lead.

Pay Rates

- Senior Lifeguard, 19 years and over: \$47.70 per hour
- Junior Lifeguard, 18–19 years: \$33.99 per hour
- Junior Lifeguard, 14–18 years: \$29.61 per hour

Key Duties

- Supervise pool areas and promote patron safety at all times, ensuring a safe and welcoming environment for all guests.
- Respond promptly to incidents, including first aid and water rescues where required.
- Deliver a high standard of customer service by assisting patrons, answering enquiries, operating the point of sale (POS) system for admissions and sales, and addressing concerns in a friendly and professional manner
- Work collaboratively with lifeguards, staff, and the Aquatic Team Lead to support the smooth operation of the facility.
- Assist with water quality testing, facility inspections, and general pool safety procedures.
- Maintain the cleanliness and presentation of pool surrounds, amenities, and equipment to ensure a high standard of facility appearance and hygiene.
- Communicate clearly and professionally with patrons, colleagues, and stakeholders at all times.



Requirements

- A suitable level of physical fitness to perform lifesaving duties.
- Availability to work mornings, afternoons, weekends and public holidays.
- Have a positive, proactive attitude.
